#### **Agenda**

1. Fire Station Walk Through – The following issues were discussed at the workshop regarding the construction of the fire station:

#### Phillip Gaskin

- Water Line needs Hydraulic Pressure Test, 110 PSI for 48 Hrs
- Multiple large cracks in the slab
- Wire anchor cable bolts are covered in concrete
- Blocks are not level, you can see gaps between the block and the beam
- Some of the Mortar joints in block have cracks or gaps
- Doors are not level and are hitting door jam
- Block between the front bay doors were cut to short and had mortar added to fill the gaps
- Floor drains are tied into the City sewer instead of going to the holding pond

### Ralph Fisher

- Wrong anchor cable used, anchor cables are not tight
- Not enough anchor cables

- Missing multiple bracing angles
- Holes were cut into block to tie rebar together
- Doesn't appear to be enough overlap on rebar
- Doesn't think the doors can be adjusted
- Block is sticking out bad in some places over 1 ½ inches
- Anchor bolts missing in several places
- South wall not level
- Screws in roll up door frames should only be on the front not on the sides
- Awning metal is not matched up to metal on the back of the building
- Plans call for the block to be sealed but Brian Cox says it was supposed to be painted
- Find out if the site superintendent is supposed to be onsite every day

#### Jack Husband

- Stated all block cells seem to be filled with concrete like they are supposed to be
- Core samples of the slab should be done

## **Brad Bailey**

- Stated City should core the slab for itself, send off to a lab of our choosing
- All structural issues need to be taken care of immediately

**Michelle Jordan** asked **Tommy Hamm** if he had any concerns or problems reading the building plans? **Tommy Hamm** said that he has not had any issues.

**Tommy Hamm** said that there was no Geo Tech done, so there was no way to know what was under the ground and that concrete is going to crack.
