- 1. Public Hearing - Florida Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program FFY 2025** - City Engineer Hunter Baumgardner** spoke about the grant program and about the application to apply for the automatic read water meters. Adjournment


Commissioner Pettis made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 3:41 pm.
